FAQs:

What is the dress code and where do I buy attire for gymnastics?

On our website, the dress code for each class is listed in the description of the class. Choose "Classes" in the toolbar to locate your child's class. Our office staff is here to help fit you for leotards, shorts, and any gymnastics needs. We place orders on the 1st and 15th of each month, so you will have the opportunity throughout the year to refresh and replenish as your child grows.

What is the meet and why are we already talking about it in September?

The meet is a culminating exhibition of gymnastics skills in the form of a meet for gymnasts to show off all that they have learned throughout the year. The meet is held at the studio in the gym and is scheduled for May 18, 2024. Times of each individual meet will be announced in March 2024. The gymnasts will perform routines on each apparatus.

Throughout the year, there will be reminders about fees, rehearsals, and pictures relating to the meet. As we get closer to the meet, you will receive lots of information about what to expect and how to help prepare your child for this special event. If you are curious, you can find tons of information on our website under the "Meet" tab in the toolbar.

What is the Meet Fee?

A meet fee of \$125.00 will be required for each participant. The fee will cover unitard, meet t-shirt, and participant's entry fee. The fee will be due on November 10, 2023. **The meet fee is nonrefundable after November 10, 2023.** If registering after December 1, 2023, a late fee of \$25.00 will be added for expediting the order. Although we encourage everyone to participate, this is an optional event.

Why is the meet deadline so early?

The gymnasts must be sized for their leotards to ensure our custom leotards are ordered in plenty of time. The company will not start making any leotards until they have been paid for in full. If we don't order leotards by December, they will not be ready for Picture Week in April.
